## PICKING UP AND DROPPING OFF CHILDREN

---

### Our commitment

Our club is committed to providing a safe environment for the participation of children and young people in accordance with the Children & Young People's (Safety) Act 2017. Part of this is ensuring that children and young people are not left alone after training or during competitions to minimize harm or risk or harm.

### What we will do (children 12 years and under)

- Make sure parents/guardians and children know the time and location of trainings and competitions.
- Request coaches and other sporting personnel to arrive before scheduled trainings or competition times where practical.
- Ensure coaches have access to a register of parent/guardian emergency contact numbers

### What we ask you to do (children 12 years and under)

- Children 12 years and under are required to have a parent or nominated guardian present during training/competitions and other events (where possible)

### What we will do (children 13 years and over)

- When a child is going to be picked up we will aim to ensure they remain in the hall until a parent/nominated guardian has arrived. Children will NOT be allowed to leave the hall without their parent or nominated guardian (where possible)
- Where possible two adults will wait with a child until a parent/nominated guardian has arrived to collect

### What we ask you to do (children 13 years and over)

- Parents/ nominated guardian to ensure they are at least 10 minutes early to trainings, competitions and events and at least 15 minutes prior to finishing times
- If a guardian is nominated to drop off and pick up written permission is given
- collect their children from inside the training hall
- Inform the coach about any changes in arrangements for picking up your child.
